

Lambeth Palace – Visitor Information

1. Event Location

The Assembly will take place at Lambeth Palace, at 2.30pm. It is located on **Lambeth Palace Road, London, SE1 7JU**, directly opposite the Thames path and just south of Lambeth Bridge. We will have access to the following rooms:

- Old Study
- State Drawing Room

2. Arrival Instructions

Please arrive via Morton's Tower entrance.

Upon arrival:

- Enter through Morton's Tower
- Call into the Gatehouse to announce your arrival (located just inside the entrance at Morton's Tower)
- Security staff will assist with entry and directions



3. Entry and Security Requirements

- **Entry will not be permitted without ID**
- Please allow extra time for security checks

4. Directions Inside the Palace

After checking in at the Gatehouse, you will be directed to the main Palace building, and from there, to the Clergy Support Trust Welcome Desk and on to the Old Study and State Drawing Room.
